

**LOCAL LAW NO. 8 OF THE YEAR 2008 – DELEGATING TO THE CHIEF OF POLICE THE POWER GRANTED TO THE MAYOR TO REQUEST AND GRANT POLICE ASSISTANCE.**

Be it enacted by the Village Board of the Village of Alfred, Allegany County, New York as follows:

The purpose of this local law is to delegate to the Chief of Police the powers granted to the Mayor under Section 209-M of the General Municipal Law of New York State to request and grant police assistance.

**SECTION ONE – Content**

In accord with Section 209-M of the General Municipal Law of New York State there is delegated to the Chief of Police the powers granted to the Mayor under Article 10 Section 209-M of the General Municipal Law of New York State to request police assistance.

**SECTION TWO - Effective Date**

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Department of State.
